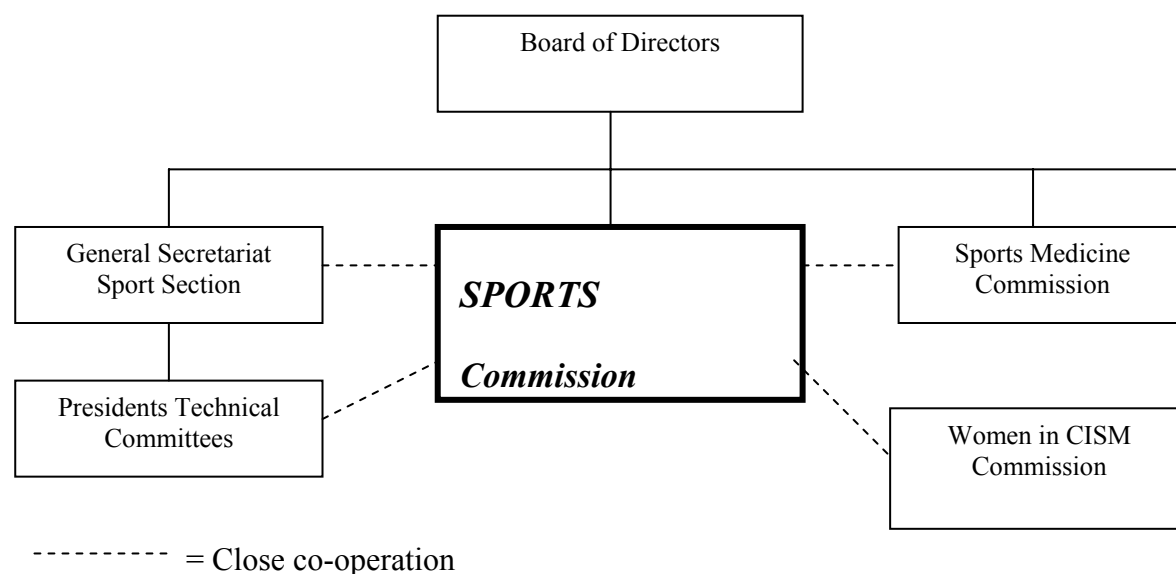

Sports Commission in the structure of CISM



General

Sports are the main product of CISM with friendship as its aim.

In organisations which grasp over a variety of activities and interests there is a need of general guidance. In the field of different sports there are numerous things and needs that can and should be co-ordinated. The limited resources for military sports both in the organisation of CISM and among our member countries have to be distributed with this taken into consideration.

Role of the Commission

The role of the Sports Commission is:

- To create possibilities for, and guidance to a positive development of sports, sports related matters and physical education within CISM and its member countries.

Objectives

To carry out the role of the commission the following objectives must be met:

- Evaluate, analyse and propose guidance in the development of sport-related matters.
- Provide oversight of co-ordination of all sporting events.

Functions

In order to obtain the objectives, the commission will:

- Undertake studies in sport related matters to assist the Board of Directors in their leadership of the organisation.
- Manage, lead and develop sports in general, sports co-ordination and physical education.
- Propose policies, procedures and/or actions in the field of mission/missions.
- Carry out studies directed by the Board of Directors.
- Present reports to the General Assembly as decided by the Board of Directors.

Mission

The mission for the Sports Commission is to promote development of sports activities and physical education in the organisation of CISM and its member countries.

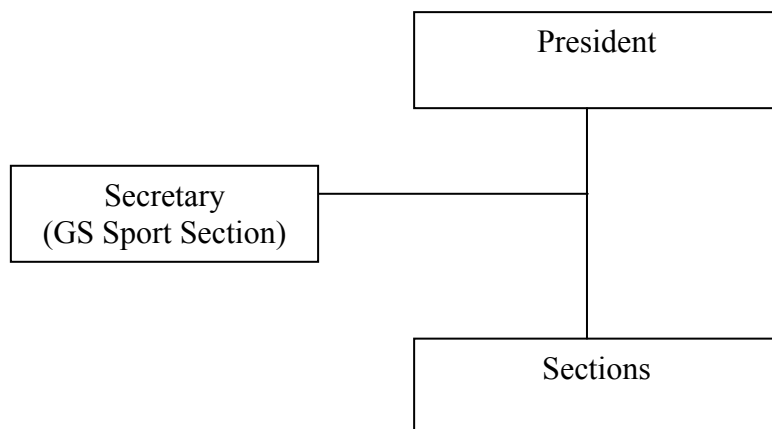
Mission success factors

The factors that will ensure a dynamic growth and development of CISM, through the SC, are the following.

- Managing by means of the SC Management Process.
- An effective Sport and Physical Education (PE) Policy.
- The equilibrium between top level Sports, Sports for all and Physical Education programs.
- Adequate resources for the execution of plans and projects.
- Dynamic relations with macro-sport and PE organisations worldwide.
- Maximum utilisation of technological infrastructure and human resources.

Organisation

The organisation of the commission is as follows:



The Commission consists of:

- A President appointed by the Board of Directors.
- A Secretary appointed by the Secretary General.
- Section chairperson appointed by the President.
- Section members appointed by the President.

Meetings

The SC meets twice a year, during the CISM General Assembly and in the period September-October.

The President will forward reports from the commission to the BoD. Minutes will be distributed according to a mailing list (set up depending of context).

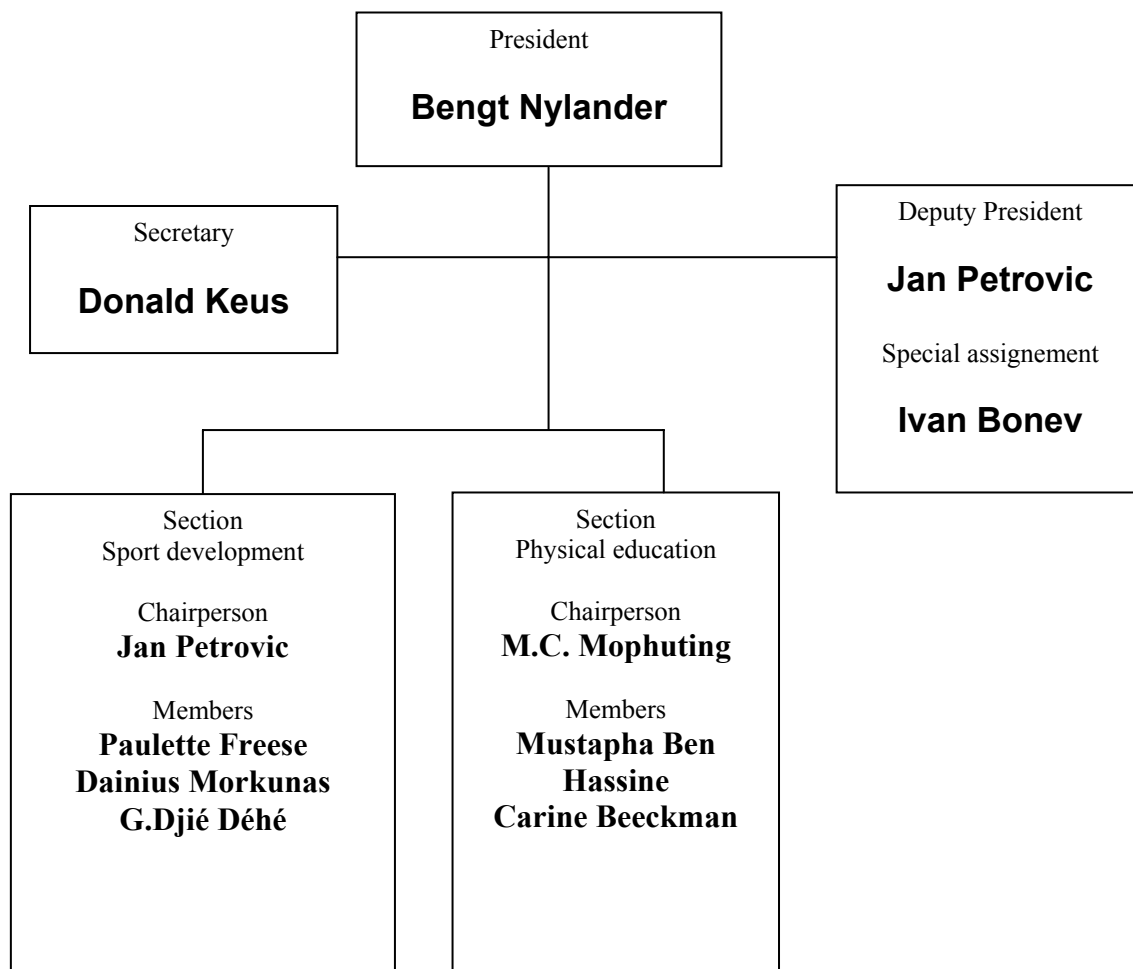

SPORT DEVELOPMENT SECTION

General

The Section is to assist CISM in achieving the objective of developing the overall sports management by analyses and evaluation of the present and present proposals for the future.

Role of the section

The role of the section is as follows:

- To lead the analyses, evaluation and proposals in the development of sport related matters.

Objectives

To carry out the role of the section the following objectives must be met:

- Analyze strategic guidelines from Board of Directors and President SC.
- Develop the overall CISM sport activities/structure.
- Advise and inform the CISM membership on developments of sport.

Functions

In order to achieve the objectives, the section will:

- Evaluate sports- and development trends.
- Evaluate and propose changes in the CISM sports structure.
- Propose any necessary policies, procedures or actions recognized through the analyzes.
- Support the PSC in preparing reports.
- Support the PSC in preparing/conducting meetings.
- Review CISM Regulations to ensure they support women's and men's competitive requirements equally;

PHYSICAL EDUCATION and SPORT SCIENCE SECTION

GENERAL

There is a permanent need for physical education within all the different sports. This must be established on a scientific based information. The section Physical Education and Sport Science was created inside the Sports Commission to assist CISM in achieving the objective of increasing the knowledge of all member countries in this field.

ROLE OF THE SECTION

The role of the Physical Education and Sports Science Section is as follows:

- Support all activities with respect to physical education and sports for all with scientific advice and support.

OBJECTIVES

The Physical Education and Sports Science Section will focus its activities on the following objectives:

- Support the member countries with the necessary scientific information of physical education, physical training and sport for all;
- Develop a medium and long-term program for symposia and courses;
- In co-operation with the Sports Medicine Commission, elaborate specific projects to improve the situation of physical education and sport for all in the Armed Forces of developing member countries;
- Encourage and support member countries to organize scientific symposia and courses.

FUNCTIONS

In order to achieve the objectives the Physical Education and Sports Science section will:

- Provide any requesting CISM member nation with the necessary information;
- Analyze, assess and propose the potential organizers of scientific symposia and courses;
- Promote the integration of CISM into other international top-level sports and sports sciences related organizations and cooperate closely with them;
- Propose any necessary policies, procedures or actions recognized through analyzes.
